From The President:

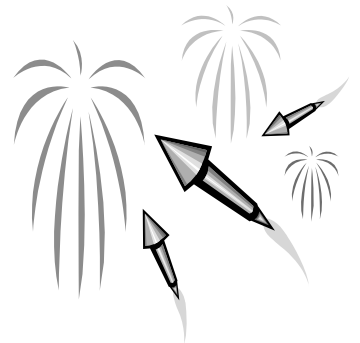

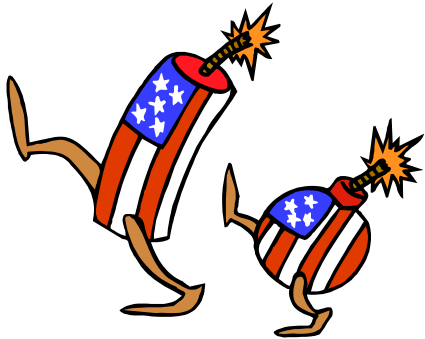
