

Sam Dicks and Gil Weidemiller entertained us with music much enjoyed by everyone. All in all it was a very enjoyable day.





#### June Recipe

#### **Blueberries with Lemon Cream**

Blending vanilla yogurt and reduced-fat cream cheese creates a topping that's as virtuous as it is delicious. Any fresh berry can be used in this recipe.

#### Ingredients

- 4 ounces reduced-fat cream cheese, (Neufchatel)
- 3/4 cup low-fat vanilla yogurt
- 1 teaspoon honey
- 2 teaspoons freshly grated lemon zest
- 2 cups fresh blueberries

#### Directions

- 1. Using a fork, break up cream cheese in a medium bowl. Drain off any liquid from the yogurt; add yogurt to the bowl along with honey. Using an electric mixer; beat at high speed until light and creamy. Stir in lemon zest.
- Layer the lemon cream and blueberries in dessert dishes or wineglasses. If not serving immediately, cover and refrigerate for up to 8 hours.


