From the President
In the last newsletter, I compared Sandalwood
Park to traditional communities, such as a town or
small city.

There are significant differences though, between Sandalwood Park and a small city or town.

Unlike in a city or town, none of us own the chunk of land that our homes sit on (thus our community is a cooperative). While our unit or share has the same number as our street address, that doesn't mean that we own the land. Each of our shares represent one 239th of the Park and its' assets, and includes a 99 year lease on the plot of land at that street address. Speaking of plots, none of our plots were surveyed when we purchased the Park. We have to determine the boundaries, with a lot of input from the neighbors and rough drawings of the Park.

Like those other communities we have a government (the Board of Directors) elected by the voting members of the community. Unlike the average town or city the members of our Board of directors receive no monetary compensation.



Like many small communities that are governed by a Board of Selectmen, one of their members is selected to be the Mayor or First selectman, or they hire a person to be the town administrator, to carry out the policies of the selectmen (in many cases that person is a professional with a degree in public administration).

In Sandalwood Park, our Board of Directors selects one member to be the president, and act in a role similar to a town administrator, in carrying out the Board's policies in accordance with our Bylaws.

Unlike cities and towns, our community is wholly owned by the majority of its residents - the shareholders. (those that do not own a share, are our tenants, and they pay rent to the landlord - SPH Inc.).

Like a small town or city we have local ordinances (The Park Rules), documents that describe how the government is to operate (the Bylaws, Chapter 719 of the Florida statutes, and the Proprietary Lease), and local building codes (The park Rules and the proprietary lease). Unlike towns, we do not have a police force to enforce the rules, or a code enforcement officer to enforce our building codes. We mainly depend on our citizens' self-interest to comply with the various rules that we all agreed to when we purchased here.

There is another very significant difference between Sandalwood Park and a town or city. In addition to being a community, Sandalwood Park Homeowners Inc. is a publically owned corporation with assets in the range of 12 million dollars (239 shares at \$50k per share is \$11,950,000). As member of the Board of Directors, I take very seriously the responsibility inherent in the management of this corporation. All Board members are trained in, and frequently reminded of their fiduciary responsibility (that is the responsibility a person or group has to handle other people's money with integrity).

The Board as always encourages suggestions from all residents for ways to improve the look and function of our park. Please inform the Office or Board member if something in the park is not right, or can be improved.




