





Marrying into Blair's family was my first experience with people who had a hearing loss. I thought when people wore hearing aids they could hear clearly.

I didn't have any understanding of severity of loss, word discrimination, nor how background noise affects hearing. I thought, they wear hearing aids, they must hear clearly.

Blair's mom, MaryEllen, had a profound loss due to surgery and wore hearing aids. Yet, she still struggled to hear. In the beginning I would get so confused. She seemed really sweet, but then she would completely ignore me. I couldn't figure it out.

I recall one time when I was walking through the garage with her, it was pretty empty and I was wearing my high-heels from work. So there was clacking sounds that reverberated in the empty garage. During all this noise I invited her to come over for dinner on Friday for a barbeque and time with the kids. She didn't respond. But, when we got to the car Blair repeated everything I just said. And with that, she lights up and says how thrilled she would be to come over.

I start fuming, what it's not good enough to come from me, it only matters if the invite comes from Blair? Now. OH, how very humbled I am. She never heard a word I said in that garage. She had no idea I had extended an invitation. Now I understand the difficulty of trying to hear in challenging situations especially when aids don't fit the loss properly.



Orange Marmalade Sweet Potatoes with Oatmeal Cookie Streusel

6 large sweet potatoes
3 cups crispy oatmeal cookie crumbs
1 cup butter, plus a bit to prep the dish
1/4 cup brown sugar
1/4 cup orange juice
1/4 cup orange marmalade
1 tbsp ginger root, peeled and grated



Preheat oven to 375°F.

Prick potatoes and bake on a baking sheet until tender, about 1 1/2 hours.

In a large bowl, mix cookie crumbs with 1/2 cup softened butter...chill until firm.


Scoop out the potato insides and mash in a large bowl together with the remaining butter, sugar, orange juice, marmalade and ginger root. Butter the inside of a 9" x 11" baking dish.

Spread the potato mixture evenly in the dish and top with the buttery cookie crumbs.

Bake 25 minutes...watch that the cookie topping does not get too brown.

Let rest a few moments and serve.
