III. RECREATION FACILITIES


4. 1The Clubhouse, pool area, shuffleboard courts and any other activity areas are for the mutual use of all Members, Tenants, invited guests and Renters.

4.2 Use of activity areas for other than regular Park functions shall require prior written approval from the Board and shall not conflict with any scheduled commitments.

4.3 Each individual Member or Tenant shall be held accountable for any physical damage to the Clubhouse, its contents, the pool, shuffleboard courts or any other recreation facilities that are cause by him/her or the visiting guests. No skating on shuffleboard courts.

4.4 Rules for each activity area shall be posted in a conspicuous place within its confines where applicable.

4.5 All chairs, tables and any equipment in the Clubhouse shall not be removed for any reason. At no time will equipment be loaned.

Sign-up for seating for dinners will be at noon three weeks before event for park residents only, two weeks before event for residents & guests, and sign-up to come down one week before event.





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
Our friend and neighbor JOHN F. FITZPATRICK passed on July 25th






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
